# 12th ISPP Annual Congress PELVIC FLOOR DISORDERS: CURRENT STATUS, TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCES AND PERSPECTIVES





#### Dear Collegues,

it is a honour to organize the 12th annual Congress of the International Society of Pelviperineology (ISPP) in Treviso, Italy. The chosen theme "Current status, technological advances and perspectives" has the ambitious aim to provide not only a consensus on the management of pelvic floor disorders, according to the evidence-based medicine and the international guidelines, but to look forward considering which are the perspectives of the new technologies. Aims of ISPP are to realize Masterclasses, Fellowships, the School for the Pelvic Floor Surgeon, as well as to develop technology partnership with all the interested Companies in this field. With this intention, nine workshops are organized to allow participants to receive hands-on training and education on specific topics.

Our thanks to Treviso Hospital and AULLS 2 Marca Trevigiana, to the School of Medicine of University of Padua and to all Sponsors. Without their efforts and support this Congress would not have been possible.

Treviso, located in close proximity to Venice and Padua, is an important cultural, economic and industrial city and has a great deal to offer for those who are willing to explore.
